Burglaries and vehicle crime has reduced over the past few months although we must not be complacent. Please continue to lock it, put car keys out of view, use security lights, park in well- lit areas, remain vigilant and call us if you see any suspicious activity.

We still are having the odd one or two across the beat area but no concentrated hot spots that require intensive work.

The festive period passed off without any significant incidents and the reports are that licensed premises were quieter than previous years.

We had an issue with a few youths acting in an anti-social manner in and around the centre of Syston. These youths have been identified through working with retailers, schools and the council. They have subsequently been advised and their details recorded and are on our radar now and if we have further problems we will escalate our approach to them.

The drugs issues we have been made aware of will continue to be a focus for us and two addresses we are already actively working on. These issues can take time to be resolved due to housing policies and forensic work once property is recovered.
