Progress since last Month.

- 1 We have been successful with our application for the final tranche of money we need to complete the Neighbourhood Plan process. We can now move along with the process to develop a (nearly) final version of Queniborough's Neighbourhood Plan.
- 2 The whole Steering Group have completed the scrutinisation of the NP and ensured that it has taken into account all the views that have been expressed throughout the process.
- 3 The Plan was presented to the Queniborough Parish Council (QPC) at their last meeting. It was well received and they have now been asked to submit any comments they have on the document prior to their next meeting (October 16th).

Next Steps

- Once those comments have been received and considered by the Steering Group they will be included _ in the NP. Approval will then be sought from the QPC at their October meeting for the document to go out for consultation.
- This is when the NP will be distributed for a six week mandatory consultation to our statutory stakeholders, local stakeholders within the village and will be available for comment by everybody in Oueniborough. Look out for posters, emails and social media letting you know how and where you can comment.
- Once that process has been completed the group will discuss and take account of all the comments and amend the document as appropriate. After this we will have a copy which will go to the QPC for final approval before it goes forward to Charnwood Borough Council and we begin the final laps of the process.
