
## Our Quest for a Neighbourhood Plan:

# Year's End is coming so it's Over to You



### Progress since last Month

- Notice of our Pre-Submission consultation was produced and sent to every home in Queniborough thanks to the good offices of the Gazette (Thanks again). Several of us spent a quiet couple of hours inserting the document into every copy of the Gazette.
- 2 The Notice was also sent by email or letter to all local stakeholders, (over two hundred in total!) including landholders, businesses and local groups e.g. The Village Hall, Brooksby Gardening Club and The Church Preservation Society. It also went to seventy three statutory bodies including nearby Parish Councils, CPRE, Highways England, Natural England and



Three Drop-in sessions were held to give people a chance to discuss the Pre-3 Submission and to give their comments directly to the Steering Group and the Notice and the pre-submission document were posted on to the Parish Council Website.

### The Official Charnwood Borough Council Mandatory Consultation Process

- The end date of our Pre-Submission consultation is Monday 9th December. So you have until that date to make any final comments.
- Once the comments from our Pre-Submission consultation process have been considered by the Steering Group they will be included in the NP. approval will then be sought from Queniborough Parish Council at their next appropriate meeting for the document to be sent to Charnwood Borough Council (CBC).
- With help from our partners (Rural Community Council and Colin Wilkinson from Planit-X) we will then produce two documents: - The Consultation Document and a Basic Conditions Statement. These documents form the basis of all the information required for our Neighbourhood Plan to go forward. CBC will then check to see that the documents fit the bill.
- This is when the final formal CBC consultation period takes place. It will again be for six weeks and will ensure that our Neighbourhood Plan conforms to the appropriate national guidelines. Once that process has been successfully completed we are on what we hope to be the final countdown!
- I'll give you more detail in the next Gazette.
- Key question is, of course, will we beat Brexit to the final 'yes' or 'no'!
