#### 4. Colin Wilkinson Feedback on grids

Colin confirmed that we need to include all comments somewhere. He complimented the groups on the grids which he found extremely useful.

Some elements from the grids will go into the Neighbourhood Plan others will go to the Parish Council (PC) for discussion and action as appropriate. The PC can also use the data from the grids to inform themselves and the Borough Councils of the current issues facing Queniborough residents.

As we go through the process two things will happen: - the NP will become more and more 'legalistic' so we need to have evidence to support our conclusions; and more and more landowners and developers will become involved and you will hear less from residents.

Colin is happy with the grids as they are currently and offered to take away the grids and develop a draft NP for us to peruse at our meeting in November (13<sup>th</sup>). There was unanimous agreement to this approach and a full round of cheers! Colin will also identify any gaps in the grids and suggest how to fill them. He will send the draft plan to Pam by November the 6<sup>th</sup>. Because of this it was decided to cancel October's meeting.
